**Incident Type:** Escort Request / verbal threat

**Location:** Anoka Technical College

**Case File #:** NA, possible restraint order pending

**Date/Time reported:** 2/9/17 @ 1142 hours

**Summary & Disposition:** ATC student reported an incident involving a verbal threat and requested an escort to her vehicle. Further information confirmed other exchanges from this individual had her concerned for her wellness and safety. Student advised on legal rights and process for requesting a restraining order. Escort concluded with no further incidents. Dean, Student Affairs contacted, along with a completion of an incident report. Student briefed to call Security for further requests of escorts.

**Incident Type:** Suspicious Activity / unlocked parked vehicle

**Location:** North Side, ATC Lot B

**Date/Time:** 2/13/17 @ 1300 hours

**Case File #:** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** ATC Student reported that their vehicle, (unlocked) had been rummaged through to include moving personal belongings within the vehicle. No property reported missing from the vehicle upon investigation. Student briefed to lock their vehicle in the future. Incident report completed.

**Incident Type:** 911 Medical Response / Student ill

**Location:** ATC

**Date/Time:** 2/21/17 @ 0926 hours approx.

**Case File #:** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** Student stated she felt like “passing out”, with a light-headed and dizzy feeling. Student was vomiting and dehydrated. 911 contacted. Paramedics arrived and student was responsive and safely transported to Mercy Hospital for further evaluation. Incident report completed and appropriate notifications on campus completed.

**Incident Type:** Minor injury / cut

**Location:** ATC, electrician shop

**Date/Time:** 2/21/17 @ 0850

**Case #:** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** Security was contacted on an ATC student who cut their finger while cutting “Sheth” off of Romex lines. The knife slipped and cut his index finger on his left hand above the first joint. Wound cleaned and bandaged, no stitches were required. Instructor was notified, incident report completed.

---

**Incident Type:** Vehicle break in / Theft of property

**Location:** Near door S3, Southside parking lot

**Date/Time:** 2/22/17 @ 1415 hours

**Case#:** 17039794, Anoka PD

**Summary & Disposition:** ATC Student reported to his instructor and to Security that his personal vehicle while parked was broken into and personal property taken from the vehicle. Items included: a gym bag, headphones, and shoes, etc. The front passenger side window was broken, with glass inside and outside of the vehicle. Police report filed with Anoka PD.

---

**Incident Type:** Simple Assault / two STEP students / minor injuries

**Location:** East Side Parking Lot, STEP bldg.

**Date/Time:** 2/24/17 @ 1155 hours

**Case #:** 17041349, Anoka PD

**Summary & Disposition:** STEP administrators requested security response for a report of two female STEP students who were fighting in the parking lot adjacent to the east side STEP building. Upon investigation, Student #1 (on foot) approached Student #2 who was sitting inside of her parked car, with her window rolled down. After a brief conversation, Student#1 took a swing at Student#2 through the open driver’s side window. Student#2 got out of

the vehicle, and a fight ensued. After the altercation, Student#1 jumped into a blue truck and departed the area. Student#1 was identified by Student#2 who made the initial report. Anoka PD notified and Officer Haugen arrived and initiated an interview and case number. All evidence provided to Anoka PD for their investigation. Notifications included STEP administration and parents of the students. Minor injuries to Student #2 consisted of loss of hair and minor scratches to the left side of her neck. Incident report was completed.

**Incident Type:** Suspicious Activity ATC Parking Lot

**Location:** ATC, Lot B near the grass hill

**Date/Time:** 2/27/17 @ 1210 hours

**Case #:** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** A vehicle parked on the curb near Lot B, ATC had what appeared to be fresh mud on the vehicle, and dig marks in the turf next to the curb. There also appeared to be fresh holes where the vehicle tires showed apparent "spin outs" on the sod adjacent to the curb. Vehicle identified and photos taken to show the extent of the "spin out". Slight damage to the ground. Incident report completed.

**Incident Type:** 911 Medical Response / Ambulance

**Location:** ATC, Room 151

**Date/Time:** 2/28/17 @ 1505 hours

**Case #:** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** Security was contacted on a student who was out of breath (but responsive) and requested ambulatory care immediately. 911 called and Allina Health responded. Ambulance arrived shortly after dispatch and treated the patient. Patient later transported to Mercy Hospital. Incident report completed.

**Incident Type:** Suspicious Activity – south lot ATC – Parked vehicle

**Location:** ATC South parking lot

**Date/Time:** 2/28/17 @ 2010 hours

**Case #** NA

**Summary & Disposition:** An ATC Student reported an unknown person in her parked car, exit the vehicle and left the area on foot. Once noticed, the person departed the

vehicle quickly, walked around other vehicles in the parking lot and left the area. Upon a quick assessment, nothing was taken from the vehicle. The student stated she left her car running and went inside the ATC bldg to use the restroom. When she exited the building and proceeded to her car, she noticed the unknown person in the driver's seat of her car. A cursory check of the exterior was conducted with negative results. Incident report completed.
