

1. What is the admission process for the OTA program?

- * Apply to Anoka Technical College and become a student
 - * Complete the ACCUPLACER Assessments
 - * **Score of 81 or higher on the Arithmetic portion** of the Accuplacer test taken within the past 2 years
OR score of 22 or higher on the Mathematics subject area of the ACT test taken within the past 2 years
OR Anoka Technical College MATH 0801 with a grade of "B" or better within the past 2 years
 - * **Score of 86 or higher on the Sentence Skills portion** of the Accuplacer test taken within the past 3 years
OR score of 18 or higher on the English subject area of the ACT test taken within the past 3 years
OR Anoka Technical College ENGL 0101 with a grade of "C" or better within the past 3 years
 - * **Score of 78 or higher on the Reading Comprehension portion** of the Accuplacer test taken within the past 3 years
OR score of 21 or higher on the reading subject area of the ACT test taken within the past 3 years
OR Anoka Technical College READ 0900 with a grade of "C" or better within the past 3 years
 - * Complete the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS for Allied Health)
 - * **Adjusted Individual Total Score of 70% or higher** on the TEAS test, version VI or ATI TEAS
 - * There is a cost associated with the test. It is the responsibility of the applicant to pay this fee.
 - * Submit application, along with proof of TEAS score to Enrollment Services
 - * Application located on OTA webpage
 - The following prerequisites must be completed and submitted as an entire package to the Enrollment Services Department. All required documentation must be submitted during the application period of October 17-21, 2016. All documents must be submitted as an entire package in person to room 117 or via email as a PDF file to enrollmentservices@anokatech.edu.
