


ProQuest Health Management provides the highest quality content and includes coverage for around 800 key journals with over 4,500 Doctoral Dissertations and Theses.

1. From the main Anoka Technical College website, hover over the **Student Services** heading to locate the **Library**.
2. Click **Health Databases**.
3. Click on **Health Management**.
4. ProQuest's Health Management database opens to a basic search screen. Check the box for *Peer reviewed*. (Fig. 1)
5. Enter your search terms. I'll enter "occupational therapy." Notice each time my search terms occur within the results, the words are highlighted.
6. See the links to related searches that pertain to your initial search (above the results list). Clicking any of these links will refine your search to narrow your results. (Fig. 2)

What is Peer Reviewed?

A publication in which articles go through an official editorial process that involves review and approval by the author's peers (people who are experts in the same subject area).

- Use the icons to email, print and/or cite your article of choice. (Fig. 4)

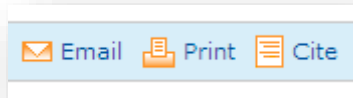



