

Part-time Course Sequence Options

Medical Coding Specialist Diploma and Health Information Technology AAS Programs

Students can choose to complete the Medical Coding Specialist Diploma and Health Information Technology AAS programs part-time. Part-time students will take longer to complete their program than students who follow the full-time sequence listed on the official program guides. Because every course may not be offered each semester, it is important for part-time students to reach out to their faculty advisors for help in planning their long-term, part-time course sequence.

Below, new Medical Coding and HIT AAS students can find the first semester part-time course options. After the first semester, work with your faculty advisors to plan future semesters.

First Semester Part-Time Course Options

Credits	Courses
6 credits total	HITM 1221, HITM 1110
9 credits total	HITM 1221, HITM 1110, INTS 1000*
*Students who have already completed the INTS 1000 requirement can take HTLH 1000 or HLTH 1005	

Developmental Courses

Both Medical Coding Specialist & HIT AAS students are required to take a college-level English course. Students with Reading Comprehension ACCUPLACER scores below college-level should take the developmental Reading & English courses required by their [placement bracket](#) in their first or second semester.

Students in the HIT AAS program need to take HITM 2000 which requires an Arithmetic ACCUPLACER score of 265 or higher. Students with lower scores should plan to take MATH 0801 Basic Math before HITM 2000.
